INFORMATION AND CRITERIA CONCERNING NOMINATIONS TO THE HUMBOLDT & DISTRICT SPORTS HALL OF FAME

Nominations may originate with an individual, club or association, and must be signed by the nominator.

Nominations should be typed and forwarded to Box 3006, Humboldt, Sask. S0K 2A0.

Nominations should outline as much factual information as possible, giving details of the accomplishments of the nominee. Where possible, the claimed details of the accomplishments or service record should be supported by documentary evidence.

Nominations for athlete, builder or team **MUST** be submitted on the forms provided by the Sports Hall of Fame.

Nominations will be reviewed by the "Nomination Review Committee". If the nomination does not meet the required criteria, the nominator will be notified following the meeting. If the nomination is accepted but not chosen for that particular year for induction, the nominator will be notified and the file reviewed the following selection period.

All files are the property of the Hall of Fame and kept for historical research purposes, accepted or retired.

ELIGIBILITY OF ATHLETES FOR NOMINATION

An athlete must:

- a) Be or have been a Humboldt or District resident.
- b) Have represented sport with distinction in an athletic competition, either in Saskatchewan or outside the province; or whose example has brought credit to the sport and high respect for the individual.
- c) Have compiled an outstanding record which extends over a period of time in one or more sports.

ELIGIBILITY OF SPORTSMEN OR SPORTSWOMEN FOR NOMINATION TO BUILDER CATEGORY

- a) Be a Humboldt or District resident during the period for which outstanding service is claimed.
- b) Have meritoriously served sport for a period of at least ten (10) years, not necessarily consecutive or in one sport.
- c) Have a career which combines, wholly or in part, the qualities mentioned in section b) above, in such a way as to make his or her contribution to sport of an outstanding nature.

ELIGIBILITY OF CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS

A team must:

- a) Be based in Humboldt or District when the win is acclaimed and documented.
- b) Be composed of area residents at the time of winning.
- c) Win either National, International, or World Championships.
- d) Be composed of more than two (2) members.

The final decision regarding induction eligibility must be ratified by the Board of Directors on the advice of the Nomination for Induction Committee.
