



Lehenga Choli

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The Lehenga Choli, also known as Lehenga, is a three-piece attire comprising the lehenga, a long Indian skirt worn by Indian women across India. Secured at the waist with the mid-riff left bare, lehenga is usually worn on ceremonial occasions, festivals and weddings. It is generally embroidered, printed or embellished and is worn with a fitting blouse called 'choli'. Additionally, the lehenga-choli is paired with a 'dupatta' which acts as a sari pallu and covers the mid-riff and head, depending on how one wishes to drape it, going by the various occasions.
