Statement from The City of Humboldt on INTERIM PROVINCIAL MANDATORY MASKING ORDER

Humboldt, SK – In response to the Provincial Government’s announcement on Thursday, September 16, 2021, re-establishing Public Health Orders of mandatory masking requirements for indoor public spaces to reduce the risk of transmittal of the COVID-19 virus, the City of Humboldt will be taking measures for the safety of our residents and our staff.

Effective Friday, September 17, 2021, masks must be worn within all public City-owned and operated facilities. This includes:

- City Hall
- Fire Hall
- Humboldt Uniplex
- Humboldt & District Museum & Gallery
- Reid-Thompson Library

These measures will remain in effect until the Province lifts these restrictions, expected in late October.

Exempt from the masking order will be indoor youth athletics under the age of 18 while they are actively engaged in athletic activity. Masking in venues hosting youth athletics, which includes the Uniplex, will remain required for general entry and exit into the facility, for athletes and spectators.

City Council and administration encourages you to protect yourself and your family. Please take necessary precautionary measures when you leave your home and are in contact with the public.
