The creation of the Dominion Telegraph line led to the establishment of the Humboldt Telegraph Station at the Original Humboldt Site.

A telegraph would enable people to communicate over great distances by sending long and short electric signals down a very, very long wire!

Catherine Weldon lived at the Original Humboldt site and became one of the first female telegraph operators in western Canada.
